

ALTA HAWK MEDALLION

The purpose of the Hawk Medallion is to encourage and challenge students to be involved in a wide variety of activities while attending Alta High School. The focus is to reward engagement and not necessarily achievement. Students may apply during their senior year. It is the student's responsibility to gather signatures and return the completed application to your counselor by **April 12, 2024**. Students will be recognized at graduation and at an awards event at the end of his/her senior year.

A student must earn a minimum of 200 points to qualify for this award. The following point values apply to each year of participation at Alta High School. Activities participated in at other schools will not be accepted. Signatures verifying participation from administrators, supervisors, teachers, counselors, and/or coaches from the respective area they supervise are required for each activity.
