Summer School Registration Information

REGISTRATION

ALL REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT IS ONLINE

- \$45 registration fee per session
- \$35 per class, up to 5 classes per session
- Previously approved **Jordan District** fee waivers accepted
- Registration is a multi-step process:
 - Fill out form at www.valleyowls.org
 - Wait for email confirming enrollment and arena scheduling instructions
 - Login to Skyward and select classes
- Registration opens May 15 at www.valleyowls.org

ATTENDANCE & CREDIT

- All classes are in person
- Each class is worth .25 credit
- Grades earned in summer school do not replace original grades
- Summer school classes are recovery credit ONLY
- Attendance is mandatory – only 1 absence is allowed per session; student will fail on the second absence
- Classwork must be completed during the summer school session – no NG's or I's
- Transcripts are sent to boundary school once grades are final
- **No refunds**
